

Public Notification of Nondiscrimination in Career and Technology Education

- 1.** Pleasant Grove ISD offers career and technology education programs in Business Education, Family and Consumer Sciences Education, Health Science Technology Education, Marketing Education, Science, and Technology Education/Industrial Technology Education. Admission to these programs is based on successful completion of prerequisite courses.
