Minutes for 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting

November 28, 2016

Members present were: Marilyn Gentry (co-chair), Michele Daugherty, William Harp, Chad Blain, Pam Bradford, Linda Erie, David Blanton, Amy Collvins and Stacy Loggins. Others present were Officer Grandy and Matt Dunn. The meeting was called to order by Marilyn Gentry. The minutes of the September 26, 2016 School Health Advisory Council meeting were reviewed and approved.

Officer Grandy PGISD School Resource Officer was invited to speak to the council regarding her role in the district. She presented a description of her credentials along with a detailed explanation of the duties she performs for the school district. Several employees commented on the positive impact she has made in the school district.

Mr. Harp reviewed the status of the PGISD Wellness Policy. The policy has been approved by the school board. It is, however, still on hold due to awaiting final regulation requirements. He also gave a detailed explanation, along with a handout, on the districts random drug testing procedures.

Marilyn Gentry provided parents with additional resources for SHAC. She also addressed possible future legislation regarding stock medication at school such as Asthma rescue inhalers, and Narcan. The expired Epi-Pens have been replaced free of charge by the EpiPens4SchoolProgram.

Amy Collvins informed the council that there will be no software changes this year for FitnessGram.

Pam Bradford reviewed the Hawk Academy activities. Linda Erie discussed the Red Ribbon Week activities and commented on the Internet Safety class taught by Public Relations Police Officer Shawn Vaughn. Matt Dunn reported on the lock down drill that took place at the HS. They all submitted reports on other health related activities since the previous council meeting.
